# **Consumer report of reactions to HPV vaccine** 10.1.4 Report 254343 submitted by a father concerned about the behaviour and physical well-being of his daughter after she received HPV vaccine was discussed. The ADRAC noted the patient's complex medical history prior to HPV vaccination, and, the consequent difficulty in discerning a clear causative role of the vaccine in the events that occurred post vaccination.

## 10.2 Vaccine reports

During the period from 22 July to 09 September 2009, 144 reports of vaccine adverse reactions were lodged. This represents about 9% of the reports lodged for the period.

# Reports of vaccines other than HPV vaccine alone

122 of the vaccine reports describe reactions to vaccines other than single-injection HPV vaccine (including 1 where HPV vaccine was administered together with another vaccine –

83 of the reports were received from States, Territories or Local Government Councils, 23 were from health professionals, 9 were from sponsors; 6 were from the AVN and 1 was from the AMEL. 97 reports related to children, 23 related to adults and age was not stated in 2.

The case reports for vaccines other than HPV vaccine alone are at Paper 10.2.1; a case line listing of these reports was provided.

### HPV vaccine reports:

22 of the vaccine reports described reactions to HPV vaccine when given as a single vaccine. These were received from VIC (9), NSW (4 – including 2 from the AVN), QLD (4), SA (1), WA (2), ACT (1) or from an unidentified State *via* the sponsor (1).

Reports in association with HPV vaccine received from July 22 to Sept 9 2009 are at Paper 10.2.2; a case line listing of these reports was provided.
